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Habilitation of cerebral palsied has used to adopt the multidisciplinary approach Nowadays professionals begin to be aware of the need to move from this traditional treatment model to a more integrated and holistic approach in early intervention. Conductive Education is a combined therapeutic and educational system that originated in Hungary and is now widespread throughout the world. This article attempts to introduce the essential principles of Conductive Education as applied to a 'Mother and Baby Group' with children aged from 12 months to 24 months in a local pre-school setting. This group has been running for one year and the mothers / caretakers are the key persons to motivate and activate their children. The progress of these children and feedback from their mothers have been very promising. The success of this program relies on the close collaboration of different disciplines. It is worth considering that new role of occupational therapist working under this Transdisciplinary Model can contribute to such positive outcome in early intervention.
