This video documents a whole day in the life of a group of motor-impaired children in the Jockey Club Conductive Learning Center (CLC). CLC has been operating its program since its opening in 1994. Based on the principle of Conductive Education, the child's whole day from morning to bedtime is carefully planned and well structured so that *every moment of the day is for learning*. Also the activities of the day take care of the motor, cognitive and psycho-social development of the children in an integrated manner to facilitate learning. This achieved through combining therapy and education in an holistic program and through ample practice of learnt skills in daily life. In this way, the life of the child is not compartmentalised into sections and learning make sense for the child. Beside demonstrating the importance of an integrated day in facilitating the child's learning, the video also strongly emphasises the importance of *motivation* in learning. Through the use of group dynamics, a thematic approach, understanding the purpose of each skill, and personal satisfaction from successful accomplishment of tasks, active and effective learning was demonstrated in these children with motor limitations.
