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For tackling the multifaceted problems of autistic children, a vast range of approaches have been developed to deal with their specific problems. Different professional develop, exchange and test approaches and ideas on the management of autistic children. Team work, especially in a transdisciplinary approach, is one of the steps to arrive at a holistic solution for the problems of autistic children. This paper attempts to introduce the transdisciplinary work on setting up a structured system for the training of autistic children in a preschool center. The team consists of an occupational therapist, speech therapist, physiotherapist, child care worker, social worker and educational psychologist. Through identification of common goals, joint program planning and cross-disciplinary program implementation, the team works in a consistent and holistic way on the programming for autistic children. As a result, it is observed that involved staff demonstrate more consistent handling and holistic management of various aspects of these children. The progress of the children in behavioural control, social skills, communication and learning abilities is noted.



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
